

AGRICULTURE

EDUCATION

Primary school and nursery teachers have one of the **highest rates of job satisfaction** in the UK. Over 450,000 teachers work all across the UK.

PUBLIC SECTOR

The Public Sector – which includes things like NHS hospitals, state schools, local councils and the police – **employs more than 5 million people** across the UK. That's over 17% of the workforce.
